



## KENNETT RIVER FAMILY CARAVAN PARK



### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### Arrival and Departure

Sites are available from 12pm and accommodation is available from 2pm. Checkout time is 10am.

#### Office Hours

Office hours are 9am-5pm, 7 days a week. After hours emergency number 03 5289 0272.

#### Amenities

Site holders will be issued with a code to the amenities block. If you have forgotten the code please ask reception. Please rinse off sand using the outdoor showers before entering the amenities.

#### Laundry

Coin operated washing machines and dryers are available for guest use. Please report any faults to the office immediately.

#### Private Property

Management does not accept any liability for loss or damage to any caravan, vehicle, tent or lost property in the park. Please make sure you secure all valuables. Lost property can be handed into the office and will be held for two weeks.

#### Cleanliness

Please ensure that campsites are left clean and tidy on departure. Including removing all rubbish from sites. Cleaning charges may apply if sites are left in an unreasonable condition.

#### Garbage

Wheelie bins are situated throughout the park and are emptied daily during peak periods. Please separate garbage and recycling. Please do not move bins from their location.

#### Security

Security personnel are on duty during the Christmas school holidays and weekends during February, March and April.

#### Visitors

All visitors must be registered at reception when entering the park. All visitors must vacate the park by 10pm.

#### Wildlife

Please do not feed the wildlife, it is detrimental to their health.

#### Hazards and Incidents

Please report all hazards and incidents to reception.

#### Water Supply

The water supplying all taps in the Park is pumped from the Kennett River. The river water goes through a three stage filtration process and is UV treated and then chlorinated. However, at this stage Colac Otway Shire recommend you do not drink the water from the taps throughout the park. The water has been deemed safe for all other purposes. There is a potable drinking water tank located next to the Camp Kitchen.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

- A speed limit of 5kph (walking pace) must be observed.
- Helmets must be worn while riding bikes, skateboards and scooters. Razor bikes, pedal racer cars and motorised scooters are not permitted
- Excessive noise, unruly behaviour, vandalism, bad language, unreasonable disturbance or any other conduct which disturbs the peaceful and quiet enjoyment of any site will not be tolerated. Park quiet time is 10 pm to 7 am.
- Adult supervision is required for persons under age 18.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult while in the amenity block.
- A maximum of one caravan, one car, and six guests (exc. infants and no more than four adults) are permitted per site.
- All fires must accord with CFA guidelines and be enclosed in an elevated fireplace. Fires are not to be left unsupervised and must be extinguished by 10.30pm. Please see management before lighting a fire.

### IMPORTANT SAFETY PROCEDURES

- In case of emergency contact 000.
- First Aid and AED available at Reception
- All vans must have fire extinguishers, fire blanket and working smoke detector.
- A space of two metres between your neighbouring camp sites is required for CFA access and to avoid the spread of fire.
- All drawbars must face the nearest park road for CFA access.
- Please familiarise yourself with the park evacuation plan, which can be found throughout the park in all facilities.
- Evacuation Assembly Points are marked on the park map. Please select an area to meet so that you can account for your friends/family.
- All guests must comply with any Total Fire Ban restrictions.
- The park BBQs are electric and can be used, however portable gas BBQs and stoves are not permitted on days of Total Fire Ban.
- In case of emergency, do not attempt to move your vehicle, caravan or tent.
